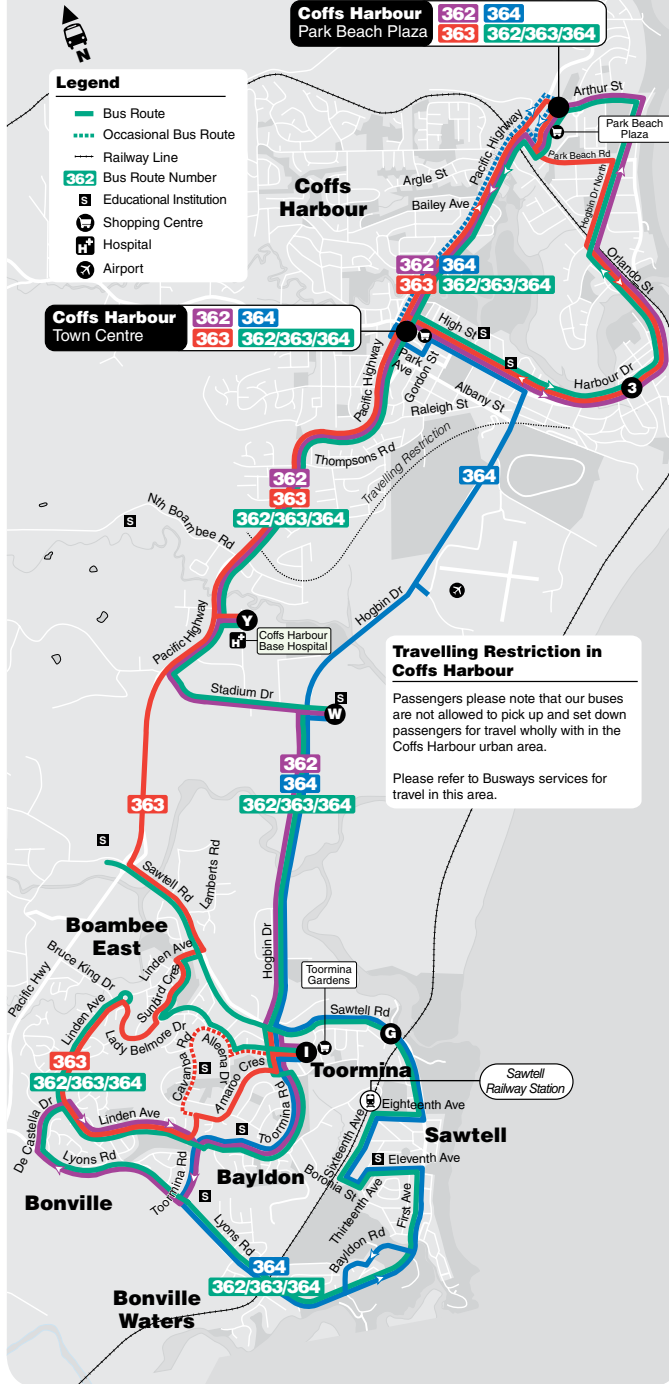




# Bus Route Map



## Fares and concession travel

Passes must be produced for concession discounts or free travel on boarding. Unreadable passes are invalid. Passengers 16 years and over are required to pay full fare unless travelling to and from school, or upon presenting your valid school pass or other valid ID.

## Lost Property

Please take all items with you before you leave the bus. If you find an item left on the bus, please notify the driver. For lost property enquiries please call 6653 3344. Please keep your bus ticket to help identify the bus travelled on.



## Hail Driver

Whilst Sawtell Coaches does use bus stops where erected, please ensure when 'hailing' that you hail the bus driver in a safe place you wish to catch, and when possible tender the correct fare. Please move to the back of the bus and make the seats available for elderly or less abled passengers, please do not eat or drink when travelling.

## Late running buses

While every effort is made to run services on time, occasionally, due to circumstances beyond our control, our buses may run behind schedule. You can rest assured that in these instances, every effort will be made to regain timetabled running as soon as possible.

## Special Events

## How to use this timetable

- Your bus is scheduled to arrive between the times shown for these points. For example, if your bus stop is situated between timing points **A** and **B** on the map, then the bus is scheduled to arrive between the time listed for **A** and the time listed for **B**.
